Schools receive a per pupil allocation in which the Principal has discretion as to how to be spend. Items can include classroom materials, student activities, field trips, technology. Instructional materials aid is allocated to the buildings based upon enrollment; however, we do allow transfer of monies should the needs the schools require. In addition, the District relies on a building needs index (1 to 4) to identify schools within the district to assist in reallocation of resources. In the 2018-19 budget, those with a 1 did not receive any additional monies; schools with 2 to 4 rating received additional funds, and the funding was weighted so that the highest needs schools received more monies.
